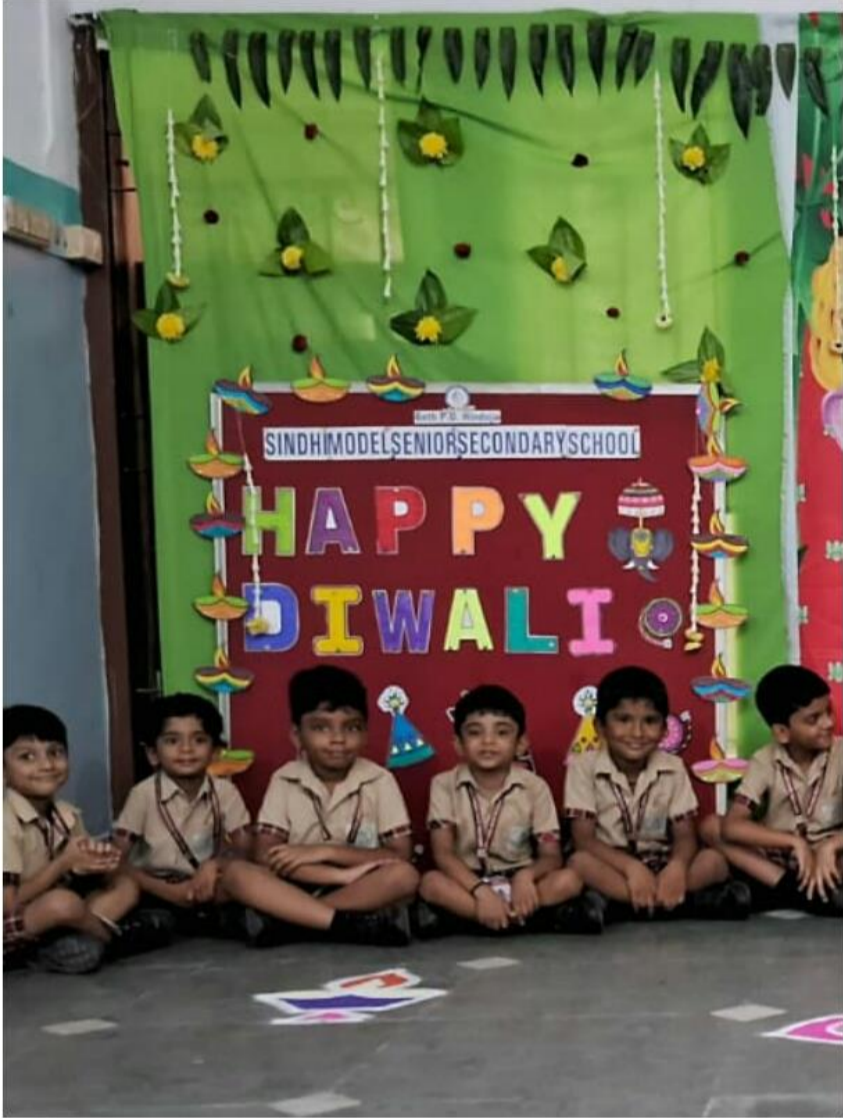
Grand entry – The celebrations radiated positivity with Pookolams decorated at the entrance of every classroom showcasing the art and culture of the festival.

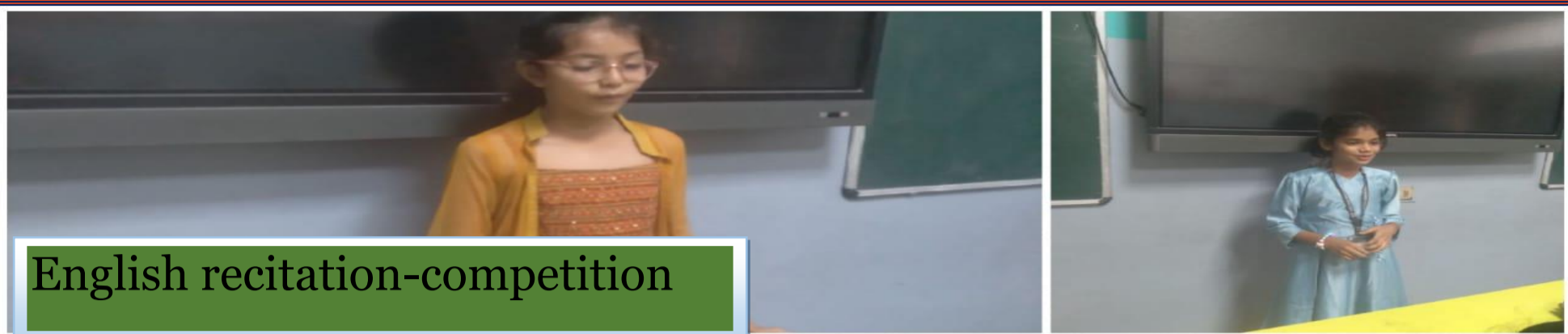

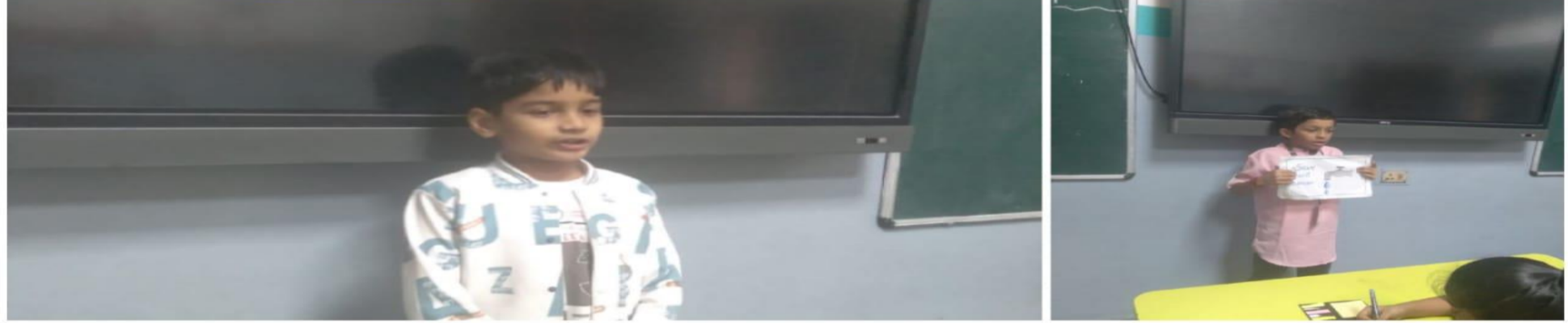

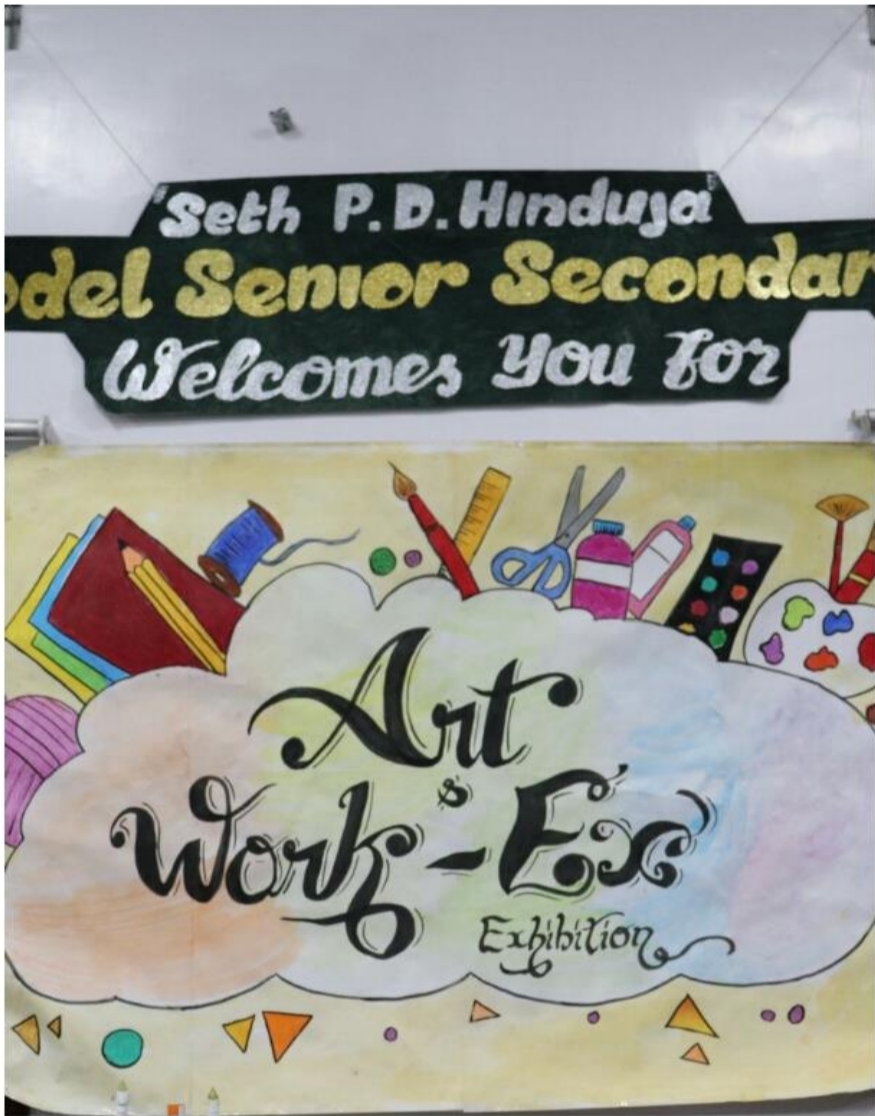

शांति का महत्व

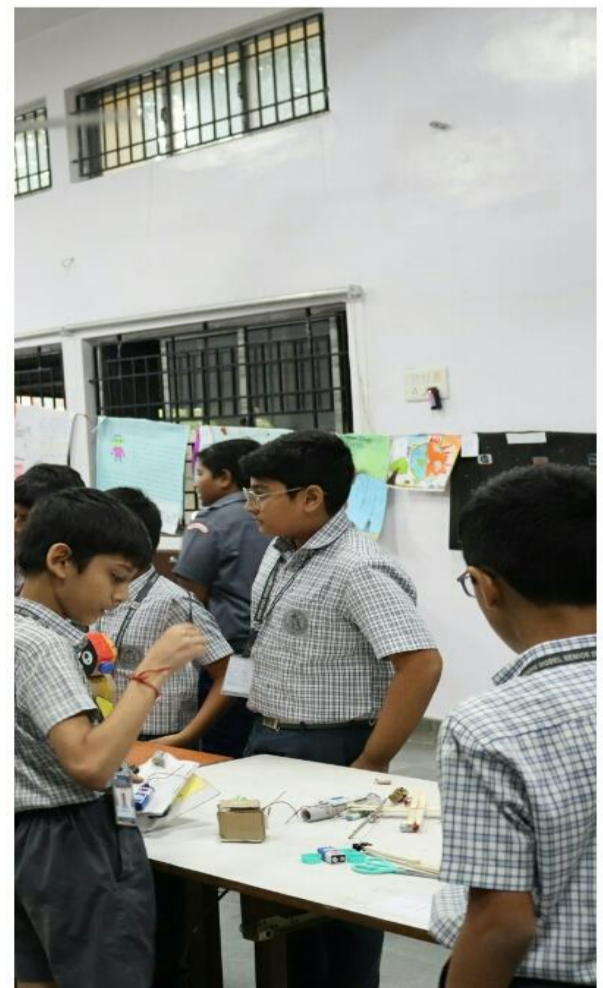
